

**APPLICATION FOR INCORPORATION OF A CORPORATION
WITHOUT SHARE CAPITAL UNDER PART II
OF THE CANADA CORPORATIONS ACT**

To: The Minister of Industry Canada

I

The undersigned hereby apply to the Minister of Industry Canada for the grant of a Charter by Letters Patent under the provisions of Part II of the Canada Corporations Act constituting the undersigned, and such others as may become members of the Corporation thereby created, a body corporate and politic under the name of

IMPACT BARRIE

The undersigned have satisfied themselves and are assured that the proposed name under which incorporation is sought is not the same or similar to the name under which any other company, society, association or firm, in existence is carrying on business in Canada or is incorporated under the laws of Canada or any province thereof or so nearly resembles the same as to be calculated to deceive and that it is not a name which is otherwise on public grounds objectionable.

II

The applicants are individuals of the full age of eighteen years with power under law to contract. The name, address and the calling of each of the applicants are as follows:

The said Rev. Greg Neuman, Rev. David Atton, and Rev. Terrance Hayes, will be the first Directors of the Corporation.

III

The Objects (Mission) of the Corporation is:

IMPACT BARRIE is a fellowship of local churches coming together under the Lordship of Jesus Christ, for the purposes of exalting Him and influencing our community with His gospel.

The Object (Mission) will be accomplished by the following activities:

- (a) coordinating city-wide initiatives that represent these churches,
- (b) holding regular meetings to discuss and make decisions concerning the social and spiritual needs of the community.
- (c) Acting as a recognized community organization through which biblical mandates (such as evangelism, giving, unity, reconciliation, etc.) may be demonstrated through.

IV

The operations of the Corporation may be carried on throughout Canada and elsewhere.

V

The place within Canada where the head office of the Corporation is to be situated is in the County of Simcoe, in the Province of Ontario.

VI

It is specially provided that, in the event of dissolution or winding-up of the Corporation, all of its remaining assets after the payment of its liabilities shall be distributed to one or more registered charitable organizations in Canada.

VII

In accordance with Section 65 of the Canada Corporations Act, it is provided that, when authorized by By-law, duly passed by the Directors and sanctioned by at least two-thirds of the votes cast at a special general meeting of the members duly called for considering the By-law, the Directors of the Corporation may from time to time

- (a) borrow money upon credit of the Corporation;
- (b) limit or increase the amount to be borrowed;
- (c) issue debentures or other securities of the Corporation;
- (d) pledge or sell such debentures or other securities for such sums and at such prices as may be deemed expedient; and
- (e) secure any such debentures, or other securities, or any other present or future borrowing or liability of the Corporation, by mortgage, hypothec, charge or pledge of all or any currently owned or subsequently acquired real and personal, movable and immovable, property of the Corporation, and the undertaking and rights of the Corporation.

Any such By-law may provide for the delegation of such powers by the Directors to such Officers or Directors of the Corporation to such extent and in such manner as may be set out in the By-law.

Nothing herein limits or restricts the borrowing of money by the Corporation on bills of exchange or promissory notes made, drawn, accepted or endorsed by or on behalf of the Corporation.

VIII

The By-law of the Corporation shall be that filed with the application for Letters Patent until repealed, amended, altered or added to.

IX

The Corporation is to carry on its operations without pecuniary gain to its members and any profits or other accretions to the Corporation are to be used in promoting its objects.
